Please note that volunteers must be at least 16 years old to work on site, and that no one younger than 18 will be allowed to operate power tools.

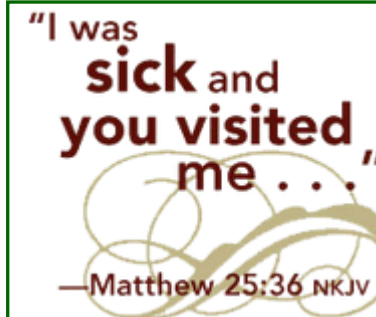
